OLD TESTAMENT

II Chronicles 7:12-14 (New Living Translation)

Then one night the LORD appeared to Solomon and said, "I have heard your prayer and have chosen this Temple as the place for making sacrifices."

"At times I might shut up the heavens so that no rain falls, or command grasshoppers to devour your crops, or send plagues among you."

"Then if My people who are called by My Name will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land."

II Chronicles 20:12; 15-17 (New Living Translation)

"O our God, won't you stop them? We are powerless against this mighty army that is about to attack us. We do not know what to do, but we are looking to You for help."

He said, "Listen, all you people of Judah and Jerusalem! Listen, King Jehoshaphat! This is what the LORD says: Do not be afraid! Don't be discouraged by this mighty army, for the battle is not yours, but God's."

NEW TESTAMENT

Colossians 1:15-16 (New Living Translation)

Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation, for through Him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see— such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through Him and for Him.

II Corinthians 5:17-18A (New Living Translation)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

And all of this is a gift from God, Who brought us back to Himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to Him.

Galatians 5:22-23A (New Living Translation)

When He appeared in human form, He humbled Himself in obedience to God and died a criminal’s death on a cross.
